# ADVANCED OFFICER TRAINING

### COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Advanced Officer Training is a 24-hour course designed to address the continuing professional training needs of Probation Officers. Course topics will include: Liability and Legal Updates, Chemical Agent Update, Arrest Control Techniques, Weapon Retention, Assisting with Vehicle Stop Familiarization, Three Man Bump Entry Techniques, and Simunition Familiarization & Safety.

Because this course is designed to provide practical hands on training in police tactics and weapon usage, participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participants.

### PREREQUISITES:

Must have completed the S.T.C. Probation required Core Course and both P.O.S.T. required (PC 832) Arrest, Search and Seizure, and Firearms Familiarization.

*Must be employed with a probation agency.*
