BASIC SWAT

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Basic SWAT is an 80-hour course designed to include instruction in Administrative Requirements, Team and Individual Equipment, Operational Planning, General SWAT Tactics, SWAT Arrest Tactics, Entry Techniques, Use of Chemical Agents, and Practical Scenarios. This course is for law enforcement officers currently assigned to SWAT teams or anticipating such assignment.

Because this course is designed to provide practical hands on training in police tactics and weapon usage, participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participants.

Successful completion of a Law Enforcement Basic Academy or equivalent as determined by Dean.
