INTRODUCTION TO PERSONAL WATERCRAFT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Introduction to Personal Watercraft for Law Enforcement is a 32-hour P.O.S.T. certified course for marine patrol and/or search and rescue. At the completion of this course, students will be able to demonstrate a basic understanding of the handling characteristics of the personal watercraft (PWC).

The course will cover mechanical inspections, launching, and retrieval of PWC demonstration of basic slow speed maneuvers, slalom course, figure 8, docking, demonstration of handling characteristics, towing, object pick up, overview and/or demonstration of rescue board functions.

PREREQUISITES: Must be assigned to a marine patrol utilizing PWC.
