COURSE DESCRIPTION: Field Training Officer Course is a 40-hour P.O.S.T.-certified course designed for officers who are assigned the responsibility of training recruit officers. Topics of study included are: Field training program goals and objectives, principles of adult learning, key elements of a successful FTO, and expectation of/for FTO's (roles of the FTO), FT program management, training/teaching skills development, override/intervention techniques, competency expectations/evaluations, remediation methodologies and strategies, documentations legal/liability issues for the FTO.
