FIRE COMMAND 1A

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Fire Command 1A is a 40-hour course designed to introduce the in-service student to the problems of commanding a fire or other hazardous incidents. It satisfies entry requirements to the Command Academy at Asilomar. The content is geared for the “First In” officer at emergency scenes. Topics emphasize the management and decision making skills required for command.

Once a student passes this course, it cannot be repeated.
