FORCE AND WEAPONRY (UPDATE)

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Force and Weaponry Update is a 24-hour course designed to train Probation Officers who are required to carry firearms in the proper escalation/use of force and the use of firearms. The course will include: Day and night shooting techniques from various shooting positions, officer survival techniques, and officer safety techniques during arrests. Students will be required to demonstrate proficiency in the agency weapon of choice during target and combat qualification exercises and arrest control techniques. Students should attend classes wearing casual clothing and rubber soled non-marking shoes. Because this course is designed to provide practical hands on training in police tactics and weapon usage, participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participants.

PREREQUISITES:

Graduate Probation Officer Core Course. Students must have successfully completed the PC 832 Arrest, Search and Seizure Course.

Students must be familiar with their weapon’s safety features and nomenclature, and be able to disassemble, clean, and re-assemble their weapon. Must be a graduate of the Probation Officer Core Course.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

Authorized service handgun (pistol or revolver), 500 rounds of factory ammunition, shooting glasses, ear protection, 2 magazines or 2 speed loaders and carriers, handgun holster utilized in service, cleaning kits, handcuffs, body armor, flashlight with extra batteries.

DO NOT BRING AMMUNITION OR LOADED WEAPONS TO CLASS ROOM. Bring all other equipment and a sack lunch on the last day of class. Note: students should expect to be physically stressed during this weeklong course.
