INTERVIEW AND INTERROGATION TECHNIQUES

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Interview and Interrogation Techniques is a 40-hour course designed for law enforcement personnel in the behavioral analysis approach to interrogation. This proven method of interrogation will be presented using a combination of lecture, demonstration, slides, and videotapes of actual confessions. Topics include: psychology of deception, vocal gestures as indicators, body language as indicators, psychology of confessions, Miranda warning review, and emotional behavior symptoms.

PREREQUISITES: Successful completion of Basic Law Enforcement Academy or equivalent as determined by the department Dean.
