PERISHABLE SKILLS & LEGISLATIVE MANDATES

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Perishable Skills & Legislative Mandates is a 24-hour course consisting of five separate P.O.S.T. certified courses: Day 1: Tactical Communication and Arrest & Control; Day 2: First Aid/CPR Recertification and Legal Update; Day 3: Tactical Firearms.

Because this course is designed to provide practical hands on training in police tactics and weapon usage, participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participants.

PREREQUISITES: Successful completion of Basic Law Enforcement Academy or equivalent as determined by Dean.

MATERIALS NEEDED: Day 1 & 2: Handcuffs, batons or ASP as carried on duty. Day 3: Duty weapon plus 200 rounds of ammunition with holster as carried on duty. Clothing appropriate for weather.
