TERRORISM/COMPUTER INVESTIGATION TECHNIQUES

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Terrorism/Computer Investigation Techniques is a 40-hour course designed to introduce investigators to the various Hi-Tech methodologies used by both domestic and foreign terrorists to fund operations or commit terrorist acts. Topics include Financial/ID fraud, cyber terror (ie: hacking, malware, stegonography, encryption), tracing emails/web pages, recognition of electronic devices, digital media, and forensic examination techniques.
