TRAFFIC COLLISION INVESTIGATION (INTERMEDIATE)

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Intermediate Traffic Collision Investigation is a 40-hour course designed to train officers how to properly inspect and document a collision scene. Students will be taught proper methodologies to identify, measure, preserve, and document evidence that is typically found at a crash site and then how to draw scale collision scene diagrams using a number of different techniques for report and court presentations. Students will also learn how to conduct a basic vehicle damage assessment and enhanced interviewing skills.

The course will use extensive practical application and field exercise, which will require additional course work outside of class hours.

PREREQUISITES:

Basic Traffic Collision Investigation

MATERIALS NEEDED:

Current vehicle code and a highlight marker pen. Clothing appropriate for weather. *Suggested items:* Digital or Polaroid camera and drawing materials.
