## FIRE COMMAND 1B

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** Fire Command 1B is a 40-hour course designed to take the student into the critical emergencies of handling hazardous materials. Instruction covers the inherent problems of commanding the scene and safely controlling and disposing of the materials. This course completes the required prerequisite to the Command Academy at Asilomar.

*Once a student passes this course, it cannot be repeated.*
