FIRE INVESTIGATION 1A

FIRE CAUSE AND ORIGIN DETERMINATION

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Fire Investigation 1A is a 40-hour course designed to provide the fire fighter with the skills and knowledge required to investigate and report on the source of fire emergencies. Legal and jurisdictional issues are covered, along with the evidence collection procedures and documentation required.

Once a student passes this course, the course cannot be repeated.
