FIRE INSPECTION PRACTICES

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Fire Prevention 1A is a 40-hour course designed to provide a broad, technical overview of fire prevention codes and ordinances, inspection practices and key hazards. Some areas of discussion include flammable and combustible liquids and gases, explosives, fireworks, extinguishing systems and others. There will be a reading assignment prior to the start of class. **(See 2nd page 2 of Flyer)**

Once a student passes this course, the course cannot be repeated.
