REGULAR BASIC COURSE Modular Format Academy- Module III

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The Regular Basic Course- Modular Format Academy- Module III is certified by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (P.O.S.T.) and is presented in the extended format.

Module III consists of 226 instructional hours. Upon successful completion on Module III the student will receive a Certificate of Completion and 9 units of lower division elective credit and may apply as a Level III reserve duty with a participating law enforcement agency.

Subject matter includes but not limited to: professional orientation, community relations, criminal law, laws of evidence, communications, vehicle operations, force and weaponry, traffic enforcement, First Aid/ CPR, criminal investigation, custody, physical fitness, and defense techniques.

Students will be required to have a driver's license and a vehicle available for range travel.

Students seeking positions with city police departments or county sheriff agencies should contact personnel offices for specific minimum hiring requirements and desirable qualifications.

Because this course is designed to provide practical hands on training in police tactics and weapon usage, participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participants.

LEGAL MANDATES:

Students will be required to physically exert themselves. It is required that each student pass a medical examination for physical fitness and submit a DOJ criminal history clearance letter.
