PERSONAL WATERCRAFT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT

OFFERED BY THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF BOATING AND WATERWAYS

COURSE DESCRIPTION: A 32-hour P.O.S.T. certified course for marine patrol officers who operate personal watercraft (PWC) as a means of patrol and/or search and rescue applications. At the completion of this course, students will be able to demonstrate a basic understanding of the technical handling characteristics of a PWC including slow and at speed operations, docking, reverse functions, towing, and enforcement operations. This class is a physically demanding course and students must be in good physical condition to participate.

PREREQUISITES: Must be assigned to a marine patrol unit utilizing Personal Watercraft.
