BOATING SAFETY AND ENFORCEMENT

OFFERED BY THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF
BOATING AND WATERWAYS

- COURSE DESCRIPTION:** A 40-hour P.O.S.T. certified course for newly assigned marine patrol officers having designated authority under Chapter 4.5 of the California Penal Code who are [or will be] actively enforcing California boating laws. This course is designed to familiarize officers with the law and its interpretation, rules of the road, carriage requirements, safety inspections, towing, theories and practices of risk management, marlinspike and seamanship, etc.
- PREREQUISITES:** Must be assigned to a marine patrol unit and proof of successful completion of an DBW approved online boating safety course (<http://www.dbw.ca.gov/> or <http://www.boatus.com/>) within the past year.
