## COPPS & POPPS

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** COPPS & POPPS is a 24-hour intensive course designed for law enforcement and crime prevention personnel. This course is intended as an introductory level program in the basic concepts of the implementation of Community Oriented Policing and Problem Oriented Policing. Topics include: History and philosophy of COPPS and POPPS; S.A.R.A. model and evaluations of POPPS; Multi-cultural issues; resource development & community mobilization; facilitation and application of skills; and the supervisor's role.

**PREREQUISITES:** Successful completion of Basic Law Enforcement Academy or equivalent as determined by Dean.
