CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL TRAINING FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES

COURSE DESCRIPTION:	<p>Continuing Professional Training (CPT) is a 24-hour course designed for the purpose of maintaining, updating, expanding, and/or enhancing an individual's knowledge and/or skills. It is training which exceeds the training required to meet or requalify entry-level minimum standards.</p> <p>The course content includes: Cultural Diversity, Racial Profiling Update, First Aid/CPR Refresher, Arrest and Control (PSP), Tactical Communications (PSP), and Court Procedures–Investigators.</p> <p>Because this course is designed to provide practical hands on training (First Aid/CPR – Arrest & Control), participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom exercises that include a risk of injury to the participants.</p> <p><i>This course is being presented for California State Department of Social Services</i></p>
