Continued Professional Training California Lottery

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Continuing Professional Training (CPT) CA Lottery is a 40-hour course designed to review courtroom procedures, courtroom testimony, update CPR skills and to refresh students Basic Academy skills with emphasis on control holds, handcuffing and defense against aggressive suspects. Students will also be exposed to Tactical Firearms Techniques.

Because this course is designed to provide practical hands on training in police tactics and weapon usage, participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participants.
