CRIME SCENE & FORENSIC PHOTOGRAPHY

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Crime Scene and Forensic Photography is a 24-hour course that provides extensive information and practical experience pertinent to crime scene and forensic photography of physical evidence. The course will begin with the basic settings and operations of a typical Digital SLR camera and proceed to advanced camera techniques and procedures to detect and photographically document a crime scene and all of its pertinent features. The course will also cover how to photographically document latent prints at the crime scene or upon various forms of physical evidence. Additional topics include: the proper selection and use of cameras, lenses, f-stops, depth-of-field, shutter speeds, fill-flash, off-camera flash, macro photography, the use of scales, tripods, filters, painting-with-light, specialized lighting techniques, laser trajectories, high energy forensic lights, and recommended photographic equipment.

REQUIREMENTS: Students are required to bring their own cameras (preferably SLR cameras – digital or film), lenses (normal, macro, & zoom), owner’s manuals, tripods, memory cards, electronic flash attachments, lens filters, and if possible any other crime scene photographic equipment and supplies issued by their department for use at crime scenes. It is also highly recommended that each student familiarize themselves with the operation and settings of their camera before the start of this course.
