CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION (NON-ICI)

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Criminal Investigation (Non-ICI) is an 84-hour course that is the same curriculum as the P.O.S.T. Institute of Criminal Investigation Core Course, but is specifically designed for State Law Enforcement Agency who do not qualify for ICI funding or Local Law Enforcement Investigators who do not wish to attend an ICI course. The Criminal Investigation includes Evidence, Interviewing Techniques, Search and Seizure, Search Warrants, Working with Victims and Witnesses, Managing Informants, Information Sources, Case Preparation, Courtroom Testimony, Media Relations, and Surveillance Techniques.

Students are required to bring a VHS video tape to be used to record their interview with a suspect.

This course is being presented for CDCR Office of Internal Affairs.

PREREQUISITES: Successful completion of Basic Law Enforcement Academy or equivalent as determined by Dean.
